IRE-ELiT signs an exclusive long-term contract with the world's largest radiopharmacy network !

September 1, 2017 — IRE-ELiT S.A. , specialized in the development and production of radiopharmaceuticals, announces the signing of an exclusive distribution agreement with Cardinal Health. Cardinal Health is the pharmaceutical group with the largest radiopharmacies network in the world (about 130) and the industry's most comprehensive portfolio of radiopharmaceuticals in the US. As part of the agreement, Cardinal Health will be in charge of the distribution for Galli Eo® Germanium-68/Gallium-68 ($^{68}\text{Ge}/^{68}\text{Ga}$) generator in the North American territory in order to support the clinical investigational trials, pre-commercial research and commercial sales in North America.

Since its creation in 2010, IRE-ELiT, the subsidiary of IRE, has been carrying various R&D programs on cancer diagnostics and treatment. In 2016, it launched, **Galli Eo**, a **Gallium-68 generator**, which represents a major advancement in the field of cancer imaging. It opens up new opportunities for the diagnostics of certain cancers, such as prostate cancer, which is the most common type amongst men, as well as the detection of neuroendocrine tumors. Many clinical trials are currently carried out in the world, opening promising solutions for other pathologies in Oncology. This diagnostics tool enables higher efficiency and greater precision compared to conventional methods. It allows a diagnostic in the early stages of the disease thereby improving the efficacy of the treatment. The generator is also innovative in terms of design, very user friendly and safe for healthcare professionals working in the nuclear medicine services.
